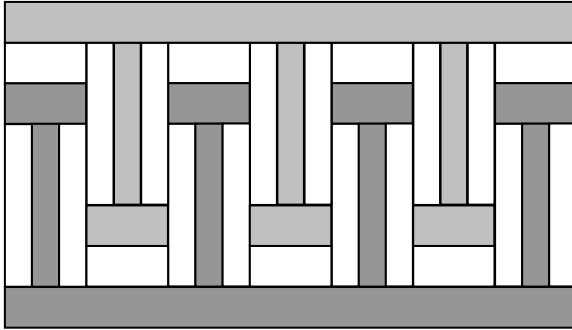


**Seminole Sampler Strip of the Month 6  
Extra Credit / Alternative  
“Maze”**



This month I am presenting an Extra Credit or Alternative strip. This strip is assembled in multiple stages.

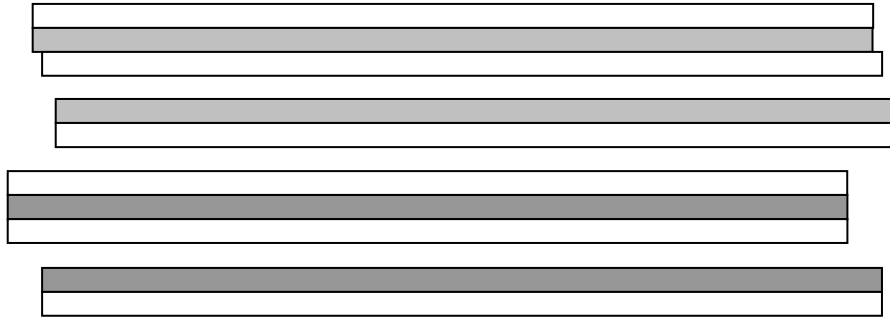
Consider making the smaller size, the double size makes a very wide strip and I think the smaller one looks better on either size quilt. The original size yields a strip approximately 5-1/4” wide, the double yields a strip approximately 6-1/2” wide. (If you think you want an even smaller size for the original, see the parenthesis.)

Also consider using a different color combination than I am presenting here. I think that, depending on your fabrics, it might look good with the dark rather than light fabric used for the maze path.

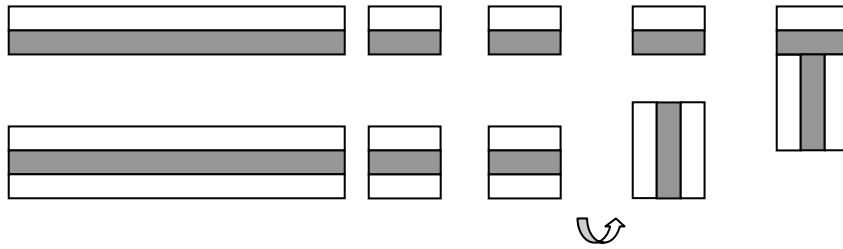
Cut your fabric as follows:

Medium	2	1" (3/4')		1-1/2"

Horizontal Strips	# of Strips	Width to Cut (Original)		Width to Cut (Double)	
Medium	1	1-1/2"		2"	
Dark	1	1-1/2"		2"	

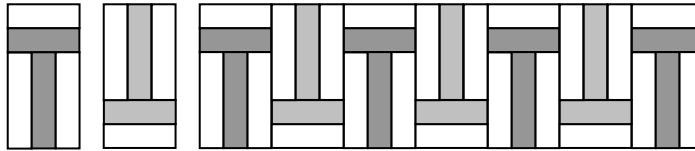
Sew four strips together as shown below. Press towards the darker fabric.



Cut into segments. Sew into pairs, making single color 'Ts'. Press the seams to either side.



Next, sew the 'Ts' together, alternating the two colors of strips as shown below.



Finally, sew the horizontal strips to the top and bottom, matching the colors to the 'Ts'.
